### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

#### **Arrival**

The boat park at Aarhus International Sailing Center is an open space for the public, that can be accessed all the time.

However, you need a code for the gate to access the boat park by car. This code will be sent to you in a separate mail within the next days in a separate email – where also the registrations link for free parking will be send.

#### If arriving before 4th June:

Remember to check in at Aarhus International Sailing Center office. The daily fee is 20 euro pr. 29er and 15 euro pr. coach boat in the period until and including 3rd June. This fee includes eventual use of parking, ramps, mooring, changing room in the Sailing Center etc. Payment upon arrival.

#### **Parking of cars, 29er trailers and RIB trailers**

If arriving by car, parking is allowed inside the boat park in the designated parking area for the duration of the event. However, be aware of local parking restrictions and register for a free parking permit during the event. The link for registration will be sent in a separate mail. If you prefer, there is also a venue close parking garage (with fee).

## Support Boats & RIB

Coach or support RIB during the event, please ensure you have registered it on the event website prior to arrival and you will also have to register on site at the Aarhus International Sailing Center office at arrival.

Moring of support boats and RIBs until and including 3rd June must be at the northern jetty as shown below.

From 4th June all support boats and RIBs must be moored at the southern jetty as shown below.

## **Fuel for coach boats**

Both 'Egaa Marina' and 'Marselisborg Marina' – our neighbour harbours has 24-hours self service gas-stations with card payment.

## **Crane Usage**

The crane marked on the venue map can be used with prior arrangement to the event and a minor fee to the local Sailing Club operating it.

Each boat will be assigned their individual Tally NFC-chip arm wrist at registration. This armband is to 'tally out' at the tally stand when you depart from shore, and to 'tally in' when you return. Please check SI for details.

You will find a large super market 'Føtex' – and also a food court – 250 meters from venue.

## **Travel to Aarhus**

When arriving in Denmark there is different option on how to get to Aarhus depending on where you are coming from.

Aarhus is a mere 170 km from the German/Danish border and the tollfree E45 highway takes you to Aarhus from Kiel in less than 4 hours. You can also fly to Aarhus Airport (AAR) which is only 30 minutes drive from Aarhus or Billund Airport (BLL) about an hour away.

From Copenhagen it is 3 hours by train to the centre of Aarhus. By car it is 3 hours. Or you can use the highspeed ferry between Sjælland/Zealand and Aarhus.
