WHAT TO EXPECT

Arrival

Arrival with trailers through North Gate. Take contacts with the harbormaster Gerard +393371080580 before arrival.

For night arrivals (23.00–05.00) call the night security +39 3713338484

Early Arrivals

Boats, Trailers and Cars can be hosted in the Club from Wednesday, April 29th to Monday, May 4th, 2026. Due to an event prior to the regatta, no boats can be accommodated outside the above-mentioned period.

On Tuesday, April 28th and after Tuesday, May 5th the current club's stationing fees will apply.

Parking

Tickets for the duration of the event will be provided at registration. Typically, one ticket per coach/crew.

- All vehicles are to be parked in assigned zones – see the Map.
- Advised if code necessary or if open only during certain hours.
- It is forbidden to access with caravans and motor homes in the parking lot and it is also forbidden to sleep in the car parking.
- The parking ticket is only for one car. It works on the outdoor parking.
- It is forbidden to park the auto in the boats space, without the permission of the harbormaster.

Parking of Rib and 29er Road Trailers

- Please entry with the trailers through the marked entry and store them in assigned place – see Map
- You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your trailer.

Support Boats & RIB Launching

If you are bringing a RIB as a coach or support boat during the event, please ensure you registered it on the event website prior to arrival and you will also have to register on site Regatta office upon arrival.

Launching of RIBs is at:

- Use the launching ramps or crane for the ribs (advised if someone needs to be called) – see Map.
- For using the crane, take contacts with the harbormaster Gerard +39 3371080580 or Tony +39 3713330756, and pay in the Office.

Petrol Station

- Location of nearest petrol station for refueling ribs is next to the crane zone – see Map.
- Opening hours 09.00–12.00 / 14.00–18.00
- Contact the harbormasters Tony +39 3713330756

Rib Parking

- Use only reserved moorings as show on the Map.

Dinghy Park

- Store the boats only in zones marked as BOATS AREA – see Map.
- Slots will be assigned.

29ers Zones 1 to 10

Please note which area you are stationed in.

29er Launching

- Launching ramps pictured in the Map.

Regatta Office

- Race office is located in the Main Club Building – see Map.
- Jury rooms are located in the Main Club Building, Room 4.
